Business Professional - On Sunday for the banquet and Capitol deliberation, AND on Monday at the Capitol, this is the appropriate attire level for this event.

<u>Appropriate</u> - Slacks, skirts, button down shirts with ties, dress/ career shoes, boots.

Not appropriate - Jeans, Shorts, leggings, tennis shoes, t-shirts.

Casual - For the Dance/Activities Time on Sunday night

<u>Appropriate</u> - Jeans, Khakis, shorts, or skirts that are <u>at least</u> midthigh length, t-shirts, tennis shoes.
